



Birchington Remembrance Day

Temporary Road Closures

The annual Birchington Remembrance Parade and Service will take place this coming Sunday. For the safety of members of the public and the various local organisations attending, Thanet District Council have authorised temporary road closures in and around The Square from 10.00am to 12.30pm and suspension of parking in Station Road. There will be shorter road closures in and around Station Road for the time it takes the parade to pass along Station Road from Alpha Road Car Park to The Square. Diversion signs will be placed in surrounding roads as appropriate. The temporary closures are detailed below:

1. Canterbury Road from Yew Tree Gardens to Kent Gardens, including The Square.
2. Park Lane from The Square to the junction with Anvil Close.
3. Albion Road, from the junction with Crescent Road to Station Road (this does not exclude use of the Car Park). There will be a Steward at the entrance to Albion Road Car Park to ensure safety.
4. Alpha Road from the junction at the car park to Station Road – once the parade moves past the road will immediately be reopened.
5. Station Road from the junction of Alpha Road to the junction with Eastfield Road (for the parade to march along Station Road).
6. Eastfield Road junction with Station Road – once the parade moves past the road is reopened.
7. Kent Gardens, entrance to Church House car park to Canterbury Road – the parade will reform following the service and immediately march off towards Albion Road car park. Once clear the road will reopen.
8. Albion Road, junction Station Road to the entrance of Albion Road Car Park. Once the parade is in the Albion Road car park all roads will be opened to traffic.

Please note that emergency vehicles will have priority if answering emergency calls and stewards will assist in ensuring the road is clear for them to pass through.
