ANNUAL CAMERA CLUB EXHIBITION RETURNS TO MARGATE

Thanet's Camera Club will stage its annual exhibition in Margate for the first time in many years this month, bringing a broad display of members' photography to one of the town's best-known seafront locations.

The exhibition will take place at The Drum, part of the Tourist Information Centre on Margate Harbour Arm, from 10 am to 4 pm on Friday 19th through to Sunday 21st June.
